Year 11 PPE 3 Examinations

The school has been able to reschedule PPE 3 examinations for Year 11 Year to begin from Tuesday 16th March. Please find attached the revised [Year 11 PPE 3 Exam Timetable](#) that has been shared with the students via the Year 11 Students (Intake 2016) Google Classroom. All students will be expected to register in their bubble rooms in the morning, and then line up outside the exam venue by 8:35am. Students will not receive study leave, and will be in their normal lessons according to their individual timetable when not in an exam.
